



Restrictions Exemption Program

Town of Stony Plain Procedures

- Anyone aged 12+ entering the facility will be screened and required to show (this INCLUDES spectators or parents):
 - proof of vaccination, or
 - medical exemption, or
 - negative test result with 72 hours of a visit to our participating facilities.
- Youth (ages 12-17) PARTICIPATING in sport, fitness, recreation and performance activities are not required to show proof of vaccination but are required to screen for symptoms; maintain 2-meters distancing (except when engaged in physical activity) and wear a mask (except when engaged in physical activity).
- Youth (ages 12-17) NOT PARTICIPATING in an activity must show proof of status/documentation to enter the arena. This INCLUDES youth spectators.
- Vaccination doses are only considered valid if administered 2 weeks prior to entry. Until October 25, 2021, proof of a single dose is considered acceptable; after October 25, proof of double vaccination is required.
- Employees, contractors, repair or delivery workers, volunteers (coaches) or inspectors entering the space for work purposes are not required to show proof of vaccination.
- Our Skate Sharpening Contractor AND any patrons wishing to ONLY use the skate sharpening services are not required to provide proof/status documentation.
- Face masks are required by AHS order in all indoor public spaces, regardless of the implementation of the Restriction Exemption Program.
- Only **ONE** point of entrance will be available for all patrons, athletes, coaches, volunteers, and support staff. **No secondary entrance will be made available to any teams during the implementation of this program.**
- Anyone refusing to comply with the regulations will not be permitted access into the facility.
- All user groups are responsible to communicate to their members, athletes, coaches, and volunteers that the Town of Stony Plain has implemented this program and the requirements must be adhered to for entry into the facility.
- We continue to require that anyone attending the facility continue to practice healthy hygiene habits; wash hands, regularly use hand sanitizer and do not attend the facility if feeling unwell.
