



COVID-19 Protocols – Group Programs Spring 2022

Compliance with regulations	All individuals must comply with the most current version of protocols. This includes Federal, Provincial, Territorial, Municipal or facility-imposed regulations or protocols as they may exist from time to time.
Skate Canada Waiver	<i>An Assumption of Risk and Waiver form must be completed by each participant prior to participation in any activities.</i>
Facility	Participant & spectators are to abide by all current Facility Restrictions & Guidelines. Follow all arena signs and procedures. Masks and REP are not required at this time, however skaters may choose to wear a mask if preferred
Self-Screen for symptoms	While the AB Government no longer requires screening for youth programs, we ask that if you exhibit any COVID-19 symptoms to NOT attend class. See our Covid-19 Updates link on our website for the current Alberta Health Daily Check List & quarantine requirements.
Contact Tracing/Attendance	Skate Canada continues to ask that we maintain Contact tracing logs for each class. Attendance sheets from coaches will be used.
Dressing Rooms	PreCanSkate – Skate tying will be in the lobby area. Chairs will be set up for use. Coaches/PA's will bring the skaters onto & off of the ice surface from the lobby area. CanSkate, Adv Can, PrePower & Jr Academy – Dressing rooms are in use for skate tying. Coaches/PA's will bring skaters onto the ice surface from the dressing room. Parents/Guardians are not allowed in the players benches.
Parents / Spectators	Parents can view the skating classes from the spectator area upstairs & are not allowed in the skater areas (Player's Benches)
Physical Distancing	Individuals are encouraged to maintain a physical distance of two metres at all times.
Personal Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wash or sanitize hands upon entry to facility and immediately after each class. • Skaters should not touch door handles, gates, benches, or other common surfaces • Personal hygiene etiquette must be practiced at all times • Wash or sanitize skating clothes, gloves, water bottles, and skates.
Sanitization	Enhanced cleaning of common touch surfaces will be maintained. This includes boards, arena door knobs, music player, etc.
